Most branches of the Richmond Tweed Regional Library Service, including Ballina, Lennox and Alstonville libraries, offer a home library service to people unable to visit the library in person. Staff from the library select items for the patron and every three weeks a volunteer delivers them in bags to the patron's house, while also picking up the bags from the previous delivery. Patrons can specify whether they would like large-print, normal print, talking books, magazines, music CDs or DVDs. They may also indicate their preferences as to authors, genres, subject-matter and whether they like fiction, non-fiction or biographies.
