What you need:

- Internet connection, Adobe Flash and a Scratch Coding Account
- Scratch can be found at <https://scratch.mit.edu/>

How to start:

- Go to <https://scratch.mit.edu/projects/267871956/>
- Click Remix
- Log into your Scratch account
- The project is yours. The pictures and backgrounds all relate to what you use at home and can be used in any way to make a game or animation
- Keep it simple, keep it clean and have fun

When you're finished:

- Select share in the top right corner
- Copy and paste the web address of your project and email it to admin@rtrl.nsw.gov.au
- Ask a big person at home if you need help with these steps
